We would like to take this opportunity to welcome each of you back. For those who are new to our community, we would like to extend a special welcome. We hope you all had an enjoyable and relaxing winter season.

Guests

Campers will be responsible for letting in their own guests. Guests will not be charged for the 2022 summer season. A camper having overnight guests, over the age of 18, requires permission from owners. If this generosity is abused, we will re-evaluate this option for the 2023 season.

Guests will need to dial the 3-digit site number (e.g. 013 for Site 13) on the gate key pad. Each 3-digit site number is assigned to a cell phone number on file and will allow you to let your guests in. You do so by pressing 9 on your cell phone key pad. You will be able to speak freely for 60 seconds or until you press 9. Please tell your guests to drive 5 mph. Only one car will be granted access at a time. The number that will call your cell is 978-939-5006. I suggest you put it in your address book/contacts in your cell phone. Sometimes traffic or vehicle noise makes it difficult to hear so please be patient.

Office/Store Hours

Between 5/6/2022 and 6/19/2022 the recreation hall will be open Friday, Saturday, and Sundays 12 pm to 5 pm. Vending machines will be available for additional hours.

Between 6/20/2022 and Labor Day, the recreation hall will be open from 12 pm to 5 pm Monday through Sunday. Some hours may be extended if needed. Vending will be available for additional hours.

Pool Hours

The pool will be open between Memorial Day and Labor Day at 12 pm and typically close around 7 pm. There will not be a life guard on duty so swimming will be at your own risk. Remember, children under the age of 14 require supervision in the pool area. Based on weather or cleaning requirements, the hours may be changed without notice.



Trash

Trash placed in the appropriate/required Peaceful Pines bags will be picked up Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays at 5 pm. Do not leave trash out overnight. Campers will be responsible for any torn bags along with any mess that is created by animals. Remember to purchase bags during store hours.
